***2016 General Safety Rules – 4 x 4 Pulling***

- 1) Drivers must be at least 16 years of age or older and hold a valid drivers license. Drivers between 16 and 18 years of age must be accompanied by parent or guardian at all times. **PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN** must sign a consent waiver as soon as minor driver is allowed in the pits. Minor drivers can **only** drive vehicle on the “track”. A legal adult must drive vehicle around in the pits, to starting line, and from the finish line. Officials at pull reserve the right to revoke this privilege at any time.
- 2) Minor drivers with a valid license wishing to drive in the enhanced, super-stock, or doodlebug classes may do so if they meet the above criteria, as well as the vehicle pulling in the three aforementioned classes needs to be outfitted with an operable tether type kill switch.
- 3) Sled operator reserves the right to disallow any minor competitor that acts in an unsafe manor, or of questionable ability.
- 4) All competing vehicles must be weighed with operator that will be competing in that weight class.
- 5) A vehicle may enter a given class only once.
- 6) All drivers must be clean and neatly attired – shirts required.
- 7) All trucks must be clean in appearance.
- 8) The driver **MUST** have complete control at all times – **NO HOT RODDING**
- 9) All vehicles must be in neutral or park while being hooked and hands out the window.
- 10) The driver must remain in seat during pull
- 11) The number one puller is the test puller – They may or may not take the first pull – the driver must decide hooked to the sled – If the 1<sup>st</sup> pull is not taken, they **MUST** decide immediately if they will pull again. They may re-pull in first or third position.
- 12) Each vehicle **MUST** come to the start line with a draw bar with minimum OPERABLE OPENING OF AT LEAST 3 INCHES (CLEVIS PERMITTED).
- 13) Only a mechanical failure will allow someone to pull last (out of fuel is not mechanical).
- 14) All vehicles must have brakes in working order.
- 15) No overhung weight in front of the rear bumper – Stock and enhanced classes only – Any must be secured – No weight allowed in cabs.
- 16) If original vehicle has doors, they must be on and closed.
- 17) Vehicle must have full cab and outer skins as intended by manufacture – the chassis must be covered by a complete rear body(except doodlebugs) – must have hood and grill in place.
- 18) No gas tanks or radiators in the cab unless factory installed.
- 19) Any object that hits the pulling track while hooked to the sled is cause for disqualification – including any safety item, weights, shields, drive shaft, etc.. **Not to include** u-joints, fluids, belts, or pulling number.
- 20) Any UNSPORTSMANLIKE conduct will be an IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION of truck and driver for one (1) year and ten (10) days from date of the event.
- 21) Any use of ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND/OR DRUGS will be an IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION of truck and driver for one (1) year and ten (10) days from date of the event.

**All rules will apply at registration time.**

**All vehicles MUST be ready to pull at time of registration – including fueled and safety equipment in place.**

**Violation of any rule will be a disqualification for the event in which the violation occurs – no points no money!**

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- 22) Driver and vehicle may be disqualified or moved to the rear if they hold up the event.
- 23) Any vehicle that leaves the course of boundary lines will be disqualified – The vehicle in this rule being tire tread,(not the sled) also the boundary to be determined by the judge.
- 24) Course boundaries will be marked with cones.
- 25) Front tire on truck crossing white finish line will constitute a full pull.
- 26) Any portion of trucks tire that crosses the parallel boundary lines as deemed by judges will be red flagged and considered out of bounds and disqualified for that class.
- 27) Any vehicle unable to hook before their class is over for any reason, will not be allowed to hook at a later point in time for that class.

**POINTS**

**To be eligible for points in 2014 you must make at least 3 of the first 4 pulls.**

Any vehicle disqualified for a rule infraction in any given class will have 5 (five) points deducted for that class for the first disqualification, 10 (ten) points deducted for the second offence and so on (as per the vote at the annual meeting).

This **DOES NOT** apply to weights falling off, mechanical failure, out of bounds. For weights falling off or going out of bounds you will receive no points, and for mechanical failure you will receive last place points.

**OTHER**

**All GREIVENCES** will be voiced by the end of given class. No replays allowed. Decisions made at end of class are final.

If you have a concern about another competitor's truck, bring it up at that pull.

Competitors are expected to comply with the techs at the time of a request to inspect any given vehicle on pull day to promote fairness and goodwill.

NESS reserves the right to edit these rules as needed.

**\*\*\* New from 2014\*\*\***

Kill switches required in all but Street Stock and Stock Diesel classes.  
All classes must wear helmet.

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*If the pull is being run by NESS, registration will start approximately 2 hours prior to the event start time. Please be registered before the driver meeting!*
